# Chairperson's Report

In recent weeks there has been some wastage of beers. There has been a lot of choice and maybe we need to reduce the choice. Committee decided to keep more local brewers. Also, due to the cost of living increases, we decided to have small increases of between 10 and 20p on most drinks from 1 November.

Blinds - JB had several quotes - Barsleys £622 (cheapest) Penumbra Blinds £768. Although dearer, it was felt that we would get a better deal with Penumbra (who were local like Barsleys) and the patterns were nicer. As a committee we chose the Lomond Wild Hare check from Penumbra.

The leaking roof has recently been fixed. The hot water has been playing up and basically a new water tank needs to be fitted. DWS has confirmed they will carry out works within next 3 weeks—fitting new water tank, nest thermostat for the heating and a Watchman for oil tank. Other quotes were not obtained in this instance as DWS knows the system and does annual service. Plus, he is local to the village.

A new external electric socket and replacement lights (others are malfunctioning) in front of the memorial to be fitted.
